

FORT STEUBEN SCOUT RESERVATION

Effective October 20, 2020, by advance reservation ONLY, the property is open for visits or use by ORVC units or other ORVC Scouting groups. Buildings will be open for Council/District meetings or program only. Sleeping overnight in buildings is prohibited. **Contact Cecilia at the Service Center, 304 277-2660 for reservations or Rob Sparks 304 639-4513 for work days, etc.**

The restroom/showers are open as are shelters, latrines, and campsites.

- If you are sick or have been exposed to COVID-19, please STAY HOME!
- If you are in a high-risk group, aged 60+ or have pre-existing health issues, strongly consider staying home to avoid possible exposure to COVID-19 or other illnesses.
- Prior to arriving on property, all groups must do a 'health check' of participants and verify/review necessary medical and waiver forms.
- For all unit or group events, a '**Restart Scouting Unit Checklist**' must be submitted at the time of arrival. This form should be used by units and any other group on property.
- Groups participating in a *unit, council or district* event of more than 48 hours or more must submit a copy of the 'Restart Scouting Unit Checklist' *and* copies of supporting medicals and waivers at the time of arrival. A health check will be performed.
- All Scouts, Scouters and visitors are expected to abide by CDC, State and local health and safety guidelines.
- Social distancing, use of masks and frequent hand washing is expected.
- High-touch surfaces should be disinfected morning and afternoon.
- Should the State, local or CDC requirements change or if there is a health and safety issue, the Council reserves the right to close properties or modify these expectations at any time deemed appropriate. (July 6, 2020)
