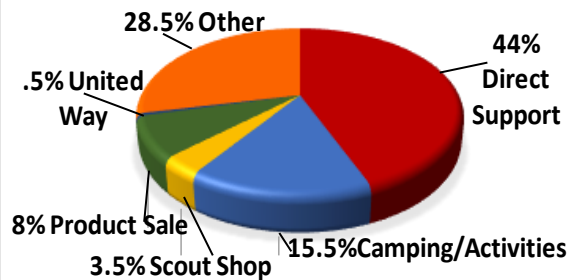

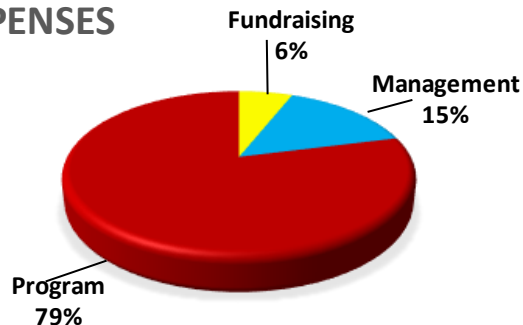
### 2019 Friends of Scouting

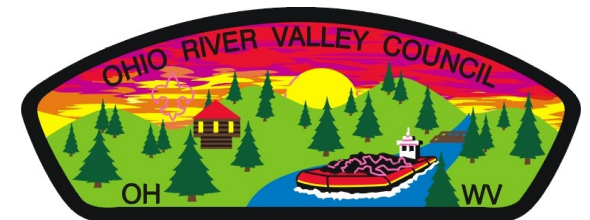
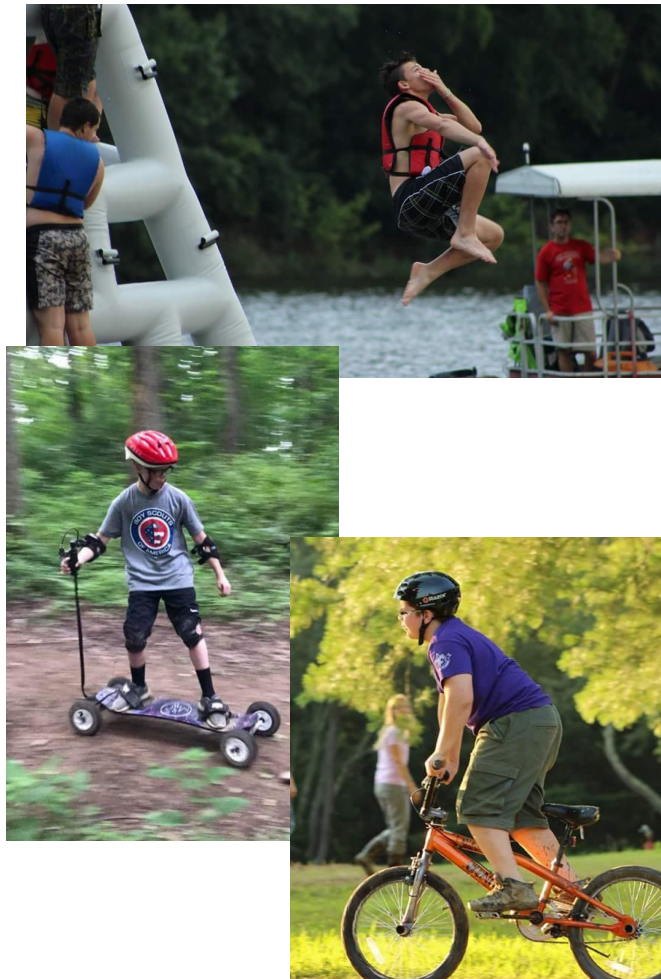
## SERVICE TO OTHERS

Each year Ohio River Valley Council Scouts learn the importance of citizenship by doing community service projects. Whether it is collecting food, participating in the Ohio River Sweep, cleaning various parks, each community service project is designed to support and enhance the communities in which we live, while teaching the importance of being a good citizen. An average of more than 5 service hours per Scout, Leader and Participant was contributed to our Council last year.



### Ohio River Valley Council Information

- 1696 Youth Members were served by our council last year.
- 43 Life Scouts earned their Eagle Scout.
- Over 1606 Merit Badges earned by Boy Scouts last year.
- 775 Adult Volunteers were served by our council.
- 9172 Service Hours were donated by our Scouts and Volunteers.
- Over 10,655 pounds of food were collected and distributed to area food banks and pantries during the Council Scouting for Food Drive this year.
